DETERMINE the key ideas of the text and create a series of questions that will help the reader to reach these.

LOCATE important academic vocabulary and find ways to integrate these words into the questions and discussion.

REVIEW what standards are addressed in the questions you have created and choose any other standards that will be the focus of this text.

5

LOCATE the parts of text that are most complex and create questions that will support students as they read these sections.

6

DEVELOP a culminating activity around #1.
